In these truly unprecedented times we are writing to you with an update regarding our office and to ensure you that we are here for you dental needs to ensure you are met during the current COVID-19 pandemic.

Per the recommendation of the Colorado and American Dental Association's, CDC and Gov.Polis Executive [Order](#), we will only be seeing patients for Urgent needs through April 14th. Therefore, if you have a preventive or non-urgent appointment we will be asking you to reschedule for after April 14th.

Next, please know that we are open for any Urgent Dental needs you may have. This means that we will see you here to ensure you do not have to go to the hospitals to get any dental needs met. We will be open for regular hours to do this at either our 1610 Canyon or 3216 Arapahoe locations. The Foothills location is currently closed but all Foothills patients can be seen at our Canyon and Arapahoe offices. If you have any urgent dental needs please give us a call at 303-442-5000 to schedule any urgent appointment instead of going to urgent care or the emergency room.

Finally, we want you to know that we are doing everything in our power to ensure the office is exceptionally clean and disinfected. We do however need your help if you do have an urgent need and need to come to our office. First, do not come if you have had a recent fever, coughing or any illness. Next, we will ask you to use hand sanitizer when entering the office and throughout your visit. Finally, we will also ask you to rinse with hydrogen peroxide prior to any work being completed in your mouth.
